

- What is the scope of Shady Grove's expansion project and what are we hoping to accomplish?
 - Connection to County water and sewer
 - Paved and lighted rear parking lot
 - Paved fire lane connecting front and rear parking lots
 - North bound turn lanes on Pouncey Tract at the South and North entrances
 - Upgraded fire system in Education Building to comply with building code
 - Upgraded fire alarm system for Fellowship Hall and Education Building to comply with building code
 - Open gathering space connecting Fellowship Hall, Education Building and Sanctuary
 - Updated worship space for Contemporary Service, which includes: audio, visual, lighting and other supporting improvements
 - 6 additional rows of pews (120 seats) in rear of sanctuary; expands seating from 320 to 440
 - New lighting for sanctuary
 - Audio upgrades and Video capability for sanctuary, including projector and projection screen
 - Expanded narthex
 - Music practice and storage area

- Changes to the approved POD (plan of development) after value engineering:
 - Eliminate the addition of 6 rows of pews at the rear of the sanctuary
 - Several dimensional changes to the narthex to incorporate the additional space that was previously occupied by new pews
 - Re-orient the new bathrooms in the gathering space; you have to look at the drawings to fully appreciate this
 - Keep the sanctuary lights instead of replacing them
 - Re-engineer the sound booth to support the management and control of audio, visual and lighting configurations
 - Keeping the existing sanctuary aisle runners; they were being replaced in the original design
 - Replacing the sanctuary HVAC units; this is a small increase to scope
 - Revisit and redesign the A/V upgrades for the sanctuary; plus, additional speakers for organ
 - Design thoughtful upgrades for contemporary worship space; engage worship consultant to identify & explore options

- Upgrade appliances in Fellowship Hall kitchen as necessary
- Redesign proposed parking plan
